

#### **BLOCK DRIVE PATTERNS – FEBRUARY 2020**

'Propeller' February 2020 Q4CL block



## **Fabrics**


<u>Either</u> orange <u>or</u> yellow. Two fabrics of your chosen colour for each block – can be plain or patterned but there must be enough contrast between the two for them not to merge together. Please <u>no</u> florals – think unisex

Fabric A	(lighter)	Fabric B	(darker)	
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Two 5¼" squares
Five 2½" squares
Four 2½" squares

## Make 4 HST (half square triangle) units:


 Take one A 5¼" square and one B 5¼" square and put right sides together. Mark along one diagonal and sew ¼" away from the mark on either side.



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2. Cut along the marked line and open out.



- Press to the dark side.
- 4. Trim to 4½".



5. Repeat with the other A 5¼" and B 5¼" squares

# Top and bottom rows:

- 6. Join one A 2½" square to one B 2½" square
- 7. Press to the dark side



- Join one of your A/B HST units to your A/B strip. NB: check the orientation of the
   HST unit use the photograph at the beginning for reference
- Join another of your A/B HST units to the other side of the A/B strip (again, checking the orientation of the HST unit)



10. Press towards the A/B strip (i.e. away from the HST units)





### Middle row:

- 11. Join 3 of the A 2½" squares and 2 of the B 2½" squares in the order A, B, A, B, A
- 12. Press towards fabric B



- 13. Join the three rows together. NB: check the orientation of the HST blocks use the photograph at the beginning for reference
- 14. Press towards the middle row



15. Check the size of the block - should be 101/2"
