

Q4CL Block Drive - November 2019
"Geese Flying Home"



Fabric

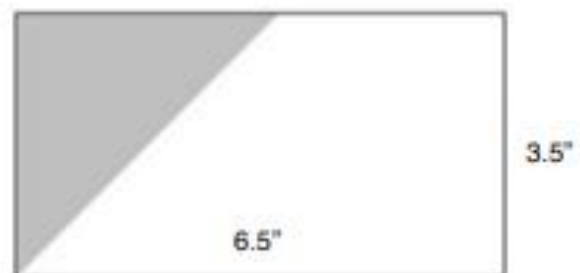
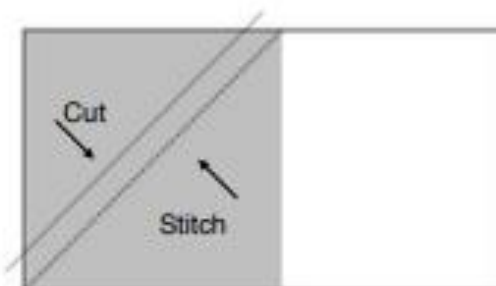
Floral A - 1 x 3.5" x 12.5" and 4 x 3.5" squares - shown in grey

Floral B - 1 x 3.5" x 12.5" and 4 x 3.5" squares - shown in orange

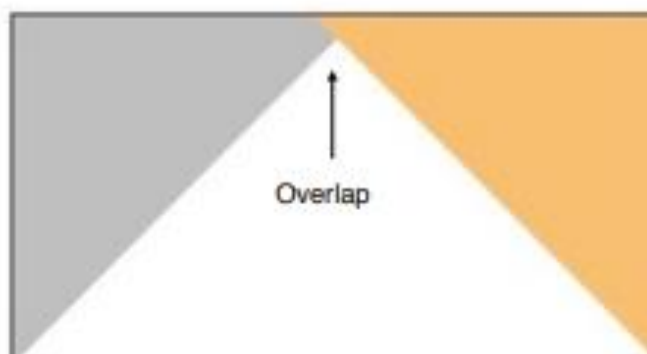
White (or white on white) 4 x 3.5" x 6.5"

All seams are 1/4".

1. Fold or mark the diagonal on each floral square. Place one floral on the end of each white rectangle and sew along the diagonal line. Trim the corner off leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam open.

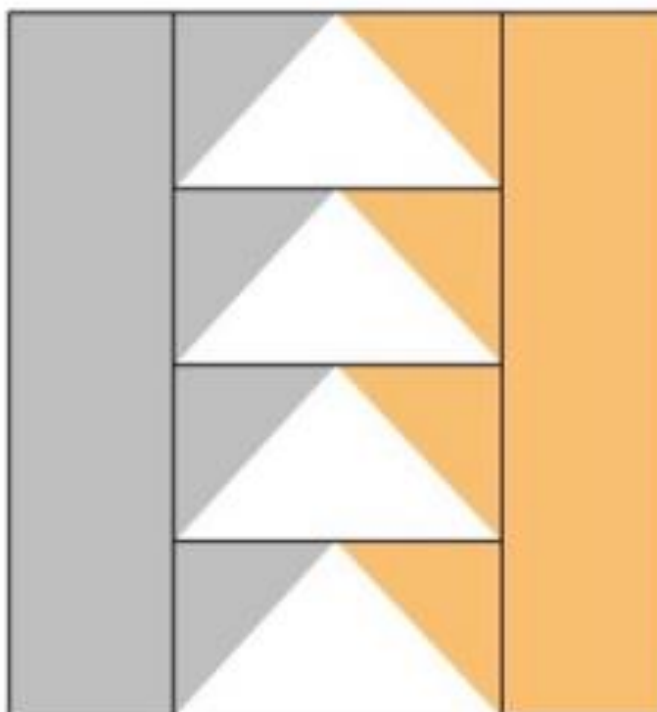


2. Repeat with the second floral on the other side of the rectangle. There will be an overlap of the floral fabrics - this is correct.



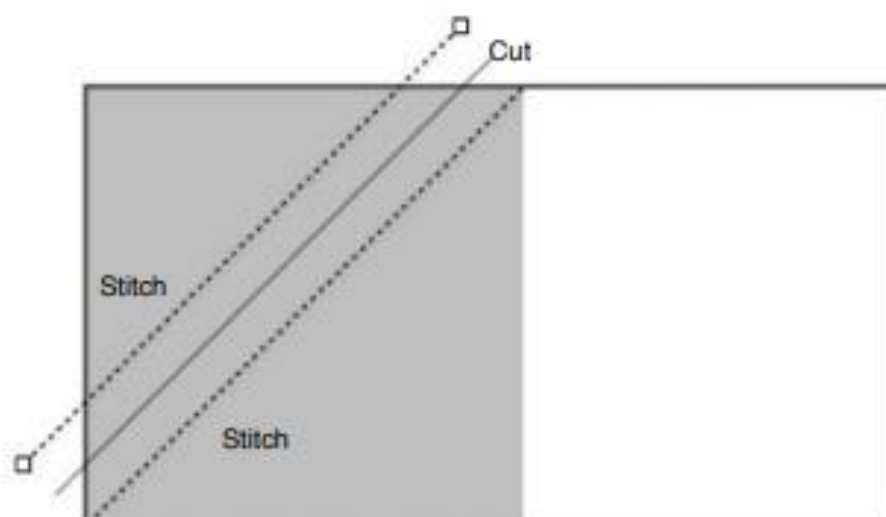
3. Repeat this with the remaining 3 white rectangles. You now have 4 flying geese sets. Sew these together along the long sides so the geese are all pointing the same way. Take care to keep the points. Once sewn press well.

4. Now add the remaining floral strip to each side of the block, pressing seams well.



5. Ensure your block measures 12.5" and send to the block co-ordinator.

* If you wish to help with some bonus blocks, after sewing the diagonal for the geese in step 1 sew a second diagonal 1/2" away and cut between the stitch lines. Once cut you then have an extra HST. Please leave these closed and un-trimmed and send them in with your blocks and we use them up in future projects!
